Survey Description

August 1980

Commencing at a point which is S 27° 57' W and a distance of 4757.0 ft from the NW Corner of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 67 East, MDB&M, and known as the Hoover Dam-Pioche Power Line Station 36+51.6, which is the intersection of the Hoover Dam-Pioche Power Line with the center line of the Prince Mine Railroad; proceed S 55° 50' 20" E a distance of 1004.70 ft to survey station CMR 1001; thence N 51° 14' 20" E a distance of 2392.76 ft to survey station CMR 1002; thence S 54° 03' 26" E a distance of 654.43 ft to survey station CMR 1010; thence S 82° 11' 22" E a distance of 231.20 ft to survey station CMR 1012; thence N 4° 58' 31" E a distance of 297.07 ft to survey station CMR 1014; thence S 82° 25' 57" W a distance of 366.87 ft to Corner No. 1 of Lot 2, this point being the beginning of the Lot 2 survey; thence N 02° 02' 19" E a distance of 164.94 ft. to Corner No. 2 of Lot 2; thence N 79° 16' 22" E a distance of 110.64 ft to Corner No. 3 of Lot 2; thence S 11° 00' 00" E a distance of 158.94 ft to Corner No. 4 of Lot 2; thence S 78° 31' 43" W a distance of 147.86 ft to Corner No. 1, this point being the beginning of this survey.
