2. Affiant states that Bayou International, Ltd. has caused, on behalf of Bayou and Bayou's Joint Venture Partner, First Investors Resources, N.L., work to be done on or for the benefit of the above said mining claims adequate to comply with the requirements for the assessment work for the period ending September 1, 1988.

3. Said labor was performed and improvements made at the instance and request of Bayou International, Ltd. and First Investors Resources, N.L., the Lessees of all of the above described mining claims.

4. At least Forty-Six Hundred Dollars (\$4,400.00) was expended by Bayou International, Ltd. and associated parties for labor and improvements for the period ending September 1, 1988.

5. Labor and improvements consisted of setting up a test plant on the Don Claims and processing a minimum of seven cubic yards of material taken from each of six different locations on the Don Claims and evaluating the results in metallurgical laboratories. Bulk samples were taken by Hal Nichols and George D. Fehr on the Castle Claims for processing at D. & H. Laboratories. Gordon Lee and Micron Mining engaged their personnel in obtaining and processing several large samples of ore from Castle Claims. In the month of August, 1988, George D. Fehr, Jeffrey L. Sagers and Shawn Ashworth obtained bulk quantities of ore from Castle, DeAubrey Jean and Roxanne Claims for analysis. Some of this ore was sent to SATEC, Ltd. in

Israel for testing, Mintek in South Africa for testing, Alpha Research Corporation in Henderson, Nevada, for analysis, Kenneth Thanstrom in San Fernando, California, for leach tests, and to other laboratories for analysis.

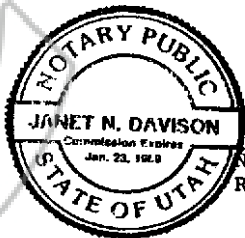

The said mining claims constitute a group or groups of contiguous mining claims leased by said corporations, and the said labor and improvements were done and made for the benefit of each and all of said mining claims comprising said group as a part of a central plan of development and tend to develop each and all of said mining claims for the purpose of holding each claim in the group.

7. The value of said work and improvements is not less than Forty-Six Hundred Dollars (\$4,600.00) and not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each of the above named mining claims.
