Affiant states that Bayou International, Ltd. has caused, on behalf of Bayou and Bayou's Joint Venture Partner, First Investors Resources, N.L., work to be done on or for the benefit of the above said mining claims adequate to comply with the requirements for the assessment work for the period ending September 1, 1988.
