She has had good control of her blood sugars and she has had no problems with hypoglycemia or hyperglycemia and has been well controlled on this medication. There is no need for insulin. Since the patient is on oral hypoglycemic agents, this should not interfere with her driving a bus or any kind of motor vehicle.
