Ms. Baldwin has been a patient of mine for many years. She has been on oral hypoglycemic agents for her diabetes for the past year or so (Glucotrol). She has had good control of her blood sugars and she has had no problems with hypoglycemia or hyperglycemia and has been well controlled on this medication. There is no need for insulin. Since the patient is on oral hypoglycemic agents, this should not interfere with her driving a bus or any kind of motor vehicle. There is nothing of concern as long as the patient is not showing signs of either hypo or hyper glycemia and is not on insulin, which she is not. The final diagnosis is Type 11 Diabetes Mellitus controlled on Glucotrol.
