MEMORANDUI OF MINING LEASE

THIS MEMORANDUM OF MINING LEASE (this "Memorandum") is made and entered into to be effective as of the Combany of the "Effective Date"), by and between Gregory S. Brainerd, Sally J. Ekren, E. B. Ekren, Doris M. Eken, Virginia Lionberger, and Bert Lionberger ("the foregoing parties are collectively referred to hereinafter as Lessor") and Alma American Mining Corporation, a Colorado corporation ("Lessee").

FECTTALS

A. Lessor and Lessee have entered into that certain Mining Lease (the "Agreement") of even date herewith. Pursuant to the Agreement, Lessor has leased the Property unto Lessee. As used in this Memorandum, the term "Property" means the entire undivided interest in the unpatented lcde claims of and under that certain Property located in Lincoln County, Nevada, described in Exhibit A. attached to and by this reference incorporated into this Memorandum, together with all rights and interests associated therewith, including, but not limited to, rights to explore, mine, process, store and otherwise develop without limitation all mineral substances together with all Lessor's rights to surface use, rights-of-way, water and water rights.

B. Lessor and Lesse: desire to execute and record this Memorandum in order to apprise third parties of their essential rights and obligations under the Agreement.

WI'INESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual premises and covenants set forth herein and in the Agreement, Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in hand paid and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Grant of Lease. Lessor has granted and conveyed and does hereby grant and convey unto Lessee, its successors and assigns, a lease unto the Property.
- 2. Term of Lease. The primary term of this Agreement shall begin on the Effective Date and, subject to extension as set forth in Section 3.1 and 10.1 of this Agreement, shall extend for a period of then(10) years, unless sooner terminated pursuant to this Agreement. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect beyond the primary term for so long as Lessee continues to pay

advance minimum royalties and otherwise to comply with its obligations hereunder.

- 3. <u>Possession</u> and <u>Control</u>. To the extent that Lessor has the power to grant such rights, Lessee shall have the exclusive right and privilege to enter upon the Property for the purpose of surveying, exploring, prospecting, sampling, drilling, developing, mining (by whatever method is now known or hereafter developed), stockpiling, removing, shipping, processing, marketing or otherwise disposing of minerals.
- 4. Purpose of Memorandum. This Memorandum is executed and recorded in order to apprise third parties of the essential rights and obligations of the parties under the Agreement. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of this Memorandum and those of the Agreement, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall in all instances prevail and govern.
- 5. <u>Interpretation</u>. This Memorandum shall be governed by the laws of the State of Nevada and shall be construed in accordance therewith.


