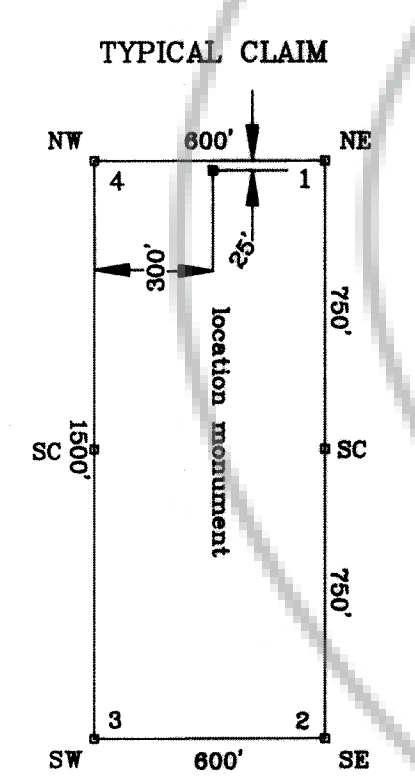


A MAP OF THE BUCK LODGE CLAIMS

All bearings are based on magnetic North using 16' E. declination.

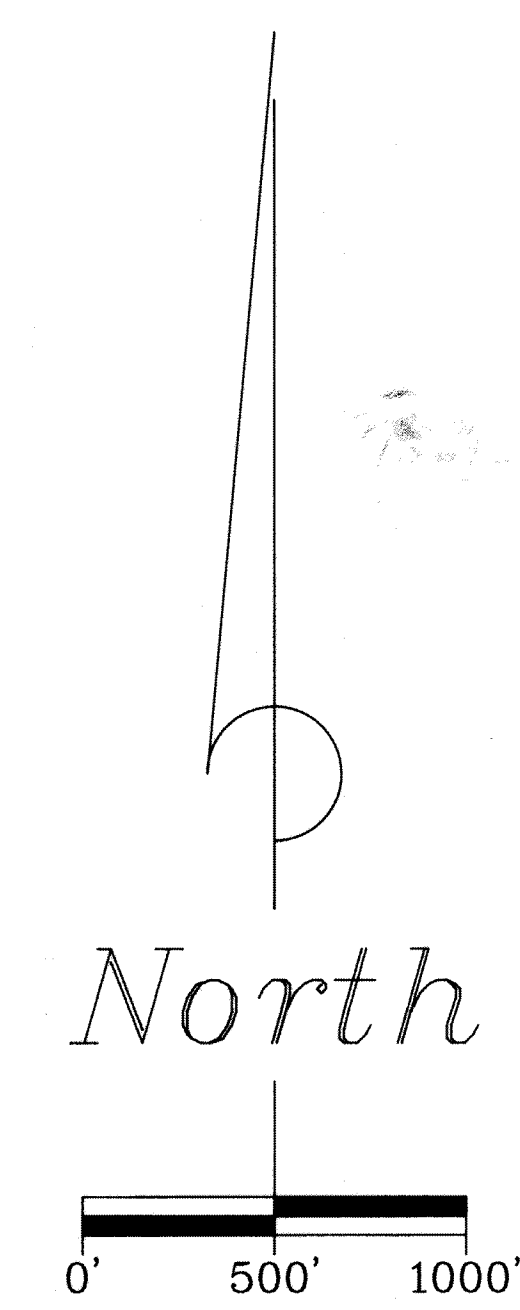
