MEMORANDUM OF MINERAL LEASE AND OPTION TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS MEMORANDUM OF MINERAL LEASE AND OPTION TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT effective as of the 28th day of May, 1991, is filed of record in accordance with the provisions contained in a MINERAL LEASE AND OPTION TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") of even date herewith, wherein:

HULSE-PARK-ELLINGSON MINE, a Nevada partnership whose address is 1737 Lamplighter Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104 and whose partners are FRANK C. HULSE and SANDRA HULSE, husband and wife, whose address is \$6 Hinman Street, Pioche, Nevada 89043, PHILIP C. HULSE and BILLIE J. HULSE, husband and wife, whose address is 6255 Casa Loma, Las Vegas, Nevada 89115, ROBERT G. PARK and JANETTE PARK, husband and wife, whose address is 3350 Wynn Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102, JAMES PARK and CYNTHIA ANN PARK, husband and wife, whose address is 3350 Wynn Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102, MILTON V. ELLINGSON and MARLYS H. ELLINGSON, husband and wife, whose address is 1737 Lamplighter Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104 ("Lessor")

granted to

GOLD FIELDS MINING COMPANY, a division of Hanson Natural Resources Company, a Delaware general partnership whose mailing address is 1687 Cole Boulevard, Golden, Colorado 80401-3301 ("Lessee")

an exclusive lease and option to purchase certain patented and unpatented mining claims located in Lincoln County, Nevada, which are more specifically described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, together with all rights of ingress and egress, all water and mining and extralateral rights appurtenant thereto, and all mine dumps, tailings, fixtures and improvements thereon (collectively, "Property") exclusive of the

Processing Area. The Processing Area means that portion of the Property described by metes and bounds in Exhibit B, together with all minerals, mineral rights, rights to surface use, water, water rights, all mine dumps, tailings, improvements, fixtures, and appurtenances in, on or under the Processing Area. The Property is leased by Lessor to Lessee for the consideration and subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement, which terms and conditions include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. GRANT OF RIGHTS. Lessor granted to Lessee an exclusive lease of the Property (excluding the Processing Area), including all ores, metals, minerals, tailings, concentrates, and mineral products ("Minerals") and all water rights appurtenant to the Property, together with the exclusive right to enter upon, possess and use the Property for exploration, development, mining, extraction, and processing of all Minerals and for all other purposes related to such operations on other properties adjacent to or in the vicinity of the Property, subject only to certain payment obligations to Lessor.
- 2. STATEMENT OF INTENT. It is the express intention of the Parties that Lessee shall have no right to conduct any mineral exploration or development activities within the Processing Area. Lessee shall have no right to manage or direct the management of activities at or with respect to the Processing Area. Notwithstanding any provision of the Agreement to the contrary, it is the express intention of the Parties that with respect to the Processing Area, Lessee shall not have any of the rights or liabilities of an "owner", "operator" or "person" as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, 42 U.S.C. \$\$9601-9657, as amended ("CERCLA"), Resource Conservation and Recovery Act 42 U.S.C. \$\$6901-6992k, Clean Water Act 33 U.S.C. \$\$1251 et. seq. and the Nevada Reclamation Act of 1989 \$\$519A 010-519A 290 or any other federal, state or local law or regulation. Nothing in the Agreement shall be deemed to preclude Lessee from qualifying as an "innocent purchaser" under CERCLA and the Agreement shall be deemed to grant Lessee all rights necessary to qualify as an innocent purchaser.
- 3. TERM. The term of the Agreement is twenty-one (21) years, to be extended so long thereafter as Lessee is making the minimum advance royalty payments ("Minimum Payments") set forth in the Agreement.

4. MINIMUM PAYMENTS AND PRODUCTION ROYALTY.

A. Under the terms of the Agreement, Lessee shall pay to Lessor Minimum Payments in the amounts set forth in the Agreement.

- B. Under the terms of the Agreement, Lessor is entitled to receive a Production Royalty on any Minerals produced from the Property and credited to Lessee.
- 5. PURCHASE OPTION. During the term of the Agreement, Lessee has the exclusive and irrevocable option to purchase the entire and unencumbered title to the Property and the Processing Area and any and all right, title and interest now owned by Lessor in any real property or mining claims located in Township 7 North, Range 68 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, in Lincoln County, Nevada, upon payment of a price set forth in the Agreement.
- 6. <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>. All of the terms and conditions of the Agreement are binding upon and inure to the benefit of Lessor and Lessee and their respective heirs, successors and assigns.
- 7. <u>COUNTERPARTS</u>. This Memorandum of Mineral Lease and Option to Purchase Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be fully binding on the signatory parties as if executed by all parties.

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
