ORDER SETTLING FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT OF EXECUTOR, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF ATTORNEYS! FEES AND COSTS, AND FOR DISTRIBUTION AND FINAL DISCHARGE

STEPHEN J. PITMAN, Executor of the above-entitled estate, having filed herein on the 26th day of March, 1992, his verified first and Final Account and Report together with a petition for settlement and allowance thereof, for attorneys' fees and costs, and for final distribution and discharge, said account and petition having come regularly to be heard on the 10th day of April, 1992, and no person appearing to contest said account and petition, the Court having considered the same and examined the evidence in this matter finds:

 That due and legal notice of the time and place of hearing of said account and petition has been given in the manner required by law;

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- 2. That said account appears to be correct and made according to law, and that all allegations in said petition are true;
- 3. That on March 26, 1992, the Executor filed herein his first and final account and report of all transactions of the estate;
- 4. That more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since the date of first publication of the Notice to Creditors, and the one creditor's claim were filed in this estate has been satisfied and a release thereof filed herein;
- 5. That DON W. ASHWORTH was originally retained as attorney for the estate on or about September 1, 1991, however JEFFREY L. BURR & ASSOCIATES was substituted in as attorneys of record for the estate in accordance with a SUBSTITUTION OF ATTORNEYS signed on January 13, 1992 and filed herein on February 14, 1992, and it was originally agreed that a flat fee of \$2,500.00 would be paid for administering this estate, and further, that said attorney would be reimbursed for all costs advanced by the attorney on behalf of the estate. Those fees and costs in the respective amounts of \$2,500.00 and \$150.00 are reasonable in consideration of the time spent and services rendered. That no sums have been paid by the Executor to apply toward fees or costs;
- 6. That all debts, expenses and charges of administration have been paid and accounted for except for attorneys' fees and costs as hereinafter allowed, and that after payment of the same, this estate will be in a proper condition to be finally settled and distributed to the beneficiaries hereinafter

named.

The Court therefore settles said account and makes its Orders and Decrees as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the First and Final Account and Report of the Executor be, and it hereby is, settled, allowed and approved, and all actions taken by the Executor in connection with the administration of the estate are hereby ratified and approved;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Executor has waived a commission for his services herein;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Executor is hereby authorized and directed to forthwith pay the law firm of JEFFREY L. BURR & ASSOCIATES the sum of \$2,650.00 as its fee for services rendered as attorneys for the estate, and costs advanced in connection with the administration of the estate;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that in accordance with the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, the Executor is authorized and directed to distribute the property remaining in the estate, as follows:

All of [my] interest in and to [my] household furniture, furnishings and supplies, carpets, books, silverware, dishes, pictures, musical instruments and all similar items of domestic use and adornment, together with all of [my] personal effects, including clothing, jewelry, and items of similar nature shall be distributed according to a letter which I will write in accordance with NRS 133.045. . . . then I direct that the items . . . be distributed to my son, STEPHEN J. PITMAN, to become his sole and separate property . . .

in accordance with that paragraph entitled <u>BEQUEST OF HOUSEHOLD</u>

<u>FURNITURE AND PERSONAL EFFECTS</u> on page 2 of the Last Will and

Testament of Leola Wilhelm Van Horn:

estate I hereby give, devise and bequeath to the Trustee under LEOLA W. VAN HORN LIVING TRUST executed this 10th day of October, 1991.

in accordance with that paragraph entitled <u>BEQUEST OF RESIDUE</u> on page 3 of the Last Will and Testament of Leola Wilhelm Van Horn.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that when the estate has been fully administered, the Executor has delivered up all of the property of the estate and has filed proper vouchers acknowledging receipt thereof, and has performed all of the acts legally required of the Executor, the Court shall then make a decree discharging STEPHEN J. PITMAN, Executor, from all liability hereafter to be incurred.

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
