The claim is approximately 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, such that 1490 feet is claimed in a Westerly direction and 10 feet in a Easterly direction from the point of discovery, at which the notice of location was posted, together with 300 feet on each side of the Monument of Location. 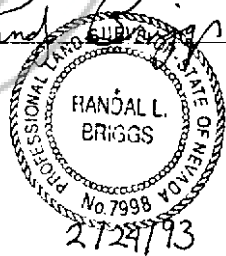
As erected, buried 1 foot in the ground and being securely capped. The corner's are marked as described above by a aluminum tag.
