CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - LODE MINING CLAIM

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

ECM, Inc., by and through its undersigned and authorized agent, hereby gives notice that it claims the land described below as a lode mining claim pursuant to the laws of the United States of America and the State of Nevada, and in making such claims and establishing its rights, states and certifies as follows:
