now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 1. All of the real and personal property of Gnolaum Unitrust is hereby declared to be property of John B. Maycock, as trustee of the bankruptcy estate of W. David Weston, free and clear of all claims and interests of all defendants in these consolidated Adversary Proceedings, namely James F. Peters, in his capacity as trustee of Gnolaum Unitrust; Vicki S. Weston; Paige Weston; Ty Weston; Brooke Weston; Drew Weston; Haley Weston; Piper Weston, Wade Weston; and Steele Weston; and A. - 2. The transfer to Vicki Weston of the debtor's rights under the Gnolaum Unitrust by the "Transfer of Rights Held by First Primary Beneficiary to Second Primary Beneficiary" dated August 31, 1990, is hereby avoided.
- 3. All rights of the debtor conveyed by the "Transfer of Rights" described in the prior paragraph are hereby divested from Vicki Weston and vested in John B. Maycock, trustee of this bankruptcy estate.
