mining claims,
Situating in the unknown Mining District, Range 66 east, Township
8 south unsurveyed sec. 33 & 34, Mount. Diablo Meridian,
Lincoln County Nevada, during the federal mining assessment work
period ending within the year 1995.

The work was done at the expense of DONALD A. AND LAWRENCE D.
BRUNDY. The owners of the contiguous mining claims, for the
