## RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada, Department of Transportation, presently holds an easement interest for all of that certain right-of-way for US-93 (Former SR-7) lying outside of a line 100.00 feet left of and parallel to the centerline of US-93 within the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 18 and within the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, all in T. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M.; and

WHEREAS, the said right-of-way is delineated by shading and identified as parcels numbered 1 and 2, on Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in NRS 403.523, the Nevada Department of Transportation Board of Directors may vacate or abandon by resolution, any portion of a state highway which has been superseded by relocation or has been determined to be in excess of the needs of the department; and

WHEREAS, a portion of said right-of-way is of no further contemplated use by the State of Nevada, Department of Transportation, due to that certain portion of US-93 (Former SR-7) being superseded by relocation.

THEREFORE, it is hereby determined by the Board of Directors of the Nevada Department of Transportation of the State of Nevada, that the following described right-of-way and incidents thereto, being all that land delineated by shading and identified as parcels numbered 1 and 2, on Exhibits "A" and "B", is hereby abandoned. Said right-of-way is more particularly described as follows: situate, lying and being in the County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, and more particularly described as being a portion of the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 18, the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, all in T. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., and more fully described as follows, to wit:

Being all that land lying outside of a line 100.00 feet left of and parallel to the centerline of US-93 lying within the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 18, T. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M.

The sidelines of said parcel are to be shortened or lengthened so as to begin on the east line of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 18, T. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M. and to terminate on the north section line of said Section 18.

## PARCEL 2

Being all that land lying outside of a line 100.00 feet left of and parallel to the centerline of US-93, lying within the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, T. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M.

The sidelines of said parcel are to be shortened or lengthened so as to begin on the east line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 7, I. 6 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M. and to terminate on the left or westerly 100.00 foot right-of-way line of said US-93.

It is the intent of the Department to abandon those portions of US-93 (Former SR-7), delineated by shading and identified as parcels numbered 1 and 2, on Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof for reference.




