TO PROTECT THE SECURITY OF THIS TRUST DEED, TRUSTOR AGREES:

- 1. To keep said property in good condition and repair, not to remove or demoksh any building thereon, to complete or restore promptly and in good and workmankke manner any building which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereon; to comply with all laws, covenants and restrictions affecting said property, not to commit or permit waste thereof, not to commit, suffer or permit any act upon said property in violation of law, to do all other acts which from the character or use of said property may be reasonably necessary, the specific enumerations herein not excluding the general, and, if the loan secured hereby or any part thereof is being obtained for the purpose of financing construction of improvements on said property, Trustor further agrees;
