## REVOLVING CREDIT DEED OF TRUST SECURITY AGREEMENT AND ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS

THIS DEED OF TRUST is dated March 15, 2000, among MATTHEW J WENNER, A MARRIED PERSON ("Grantor"); Bank of America, N.A., whose address is c/o Nevada Main Office, 300 S. 4th Street, 2nd Floo Executive Office, Las Vegas, NV 85101 (referred to below sometimes as "Lender" and sometimes as "Beneficiary"); and Equitable Deed Company (referred to below as "Trustee").

CONVEYANCE AND GRART. For valuable consideration, Grantor irrevocably grants, bargeins, sells and conveys to Trustee with power of sale for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenences; all water, water rights and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, reveities, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, (the "Real Property") located in LINCOLN County, State of Nevada:

REVOLVING LINE OF CREDIT. Specifically, without limitation, this Deed of Trust secures a revolving fine of cradit. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such balance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Grantor and Lender that this Deed of Trust secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided in this Deed of Trust and any intermediate balance.

Grantor presently, absolutely, and irrevocably assigns to Lender (also known as Beneficiary in this Deed of Trust) all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all present and future lesses of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property.

THIS DEED OF TRUST, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (A) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS INCLUDING FUTURE ADVANCES AND (B) PERFORMANCE OF EACH OF GRANTOR'S AGREEMENTS AND OBLIGATIONS UNDER THIS DEED OF TRUST. IS GOVERNED IN PART BY NRS 108.300 TO 108.400 AND THEREFORE SECURES FUTURE ADVANCES MADE BY LENDER. THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ADVANCES SECURED BY THIS DEED OF TRUST IS STATED BELOW UNDER THE DEFINITION OF CREDIT AGREEMENT, WHICH MAXIMUM MAY INCREASE OR DECREASE FROM TIME TO TIME BY AMENDMENT OF THE CREDIT AGREEMENT. THIS DEED OF TRUST IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except se otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust, Grentor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly and in a timely manner perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Credit Agreement, this Deed of Trust, and the Related Documents.

STATUTORY COVENANTS. The following Statutory Covenants are hereby adopted and made a part of this Deed of Trust: Covenants No. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of N.R.S. 107.030. The rate of interest default for Covenant No. 4 shall be 18.000% per annum. The percent of counsel fees under Covenant No. 7 shall be ten percent (10%). Except for Covenants Nos. 6, 7, and 8, to the extent any terms of this Deed of Trust are inconsistent with the Statutory Covenants the terms of this Deed of Trust shall control. Covenants 6, 7, and 8 shall control over the express terms of any inconsistent terms of this Deed of Trust.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

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Possession and Use. Until the occurrence of an Event of Default, Grantor may (1) remain in possession and control of the Property (2) use, operate or manage the Property, and (3) collect the Rents from the Property. Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in good condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at Lender's option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Deed of Trust upon the sale or transfer, without Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property or any mobile home or manufactured home located on the property whether or not it is legally a part of the real property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest in the Real Property, whether legal, beneficial or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, instalment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in the Real Property. title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of an interest in the Real Property. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Nevada law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are part of this Deed of Trust:

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, special taxes, assessments, charges (including water and sewer), fines and impositions levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall mantain the Property free of all liens having stority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the existing ness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering ell Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender, together with such other hazard and liability insurance as Lender may reasonably require. Policies shall be written in form, amounts, coverages and basis reasonably acceptable to Lender and issued by a company or companies reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor, upon request of Lender, will deliver to Lender from time the policies or certificates of insurance in form satisfactory to Lender, including stipulations that coverages will not be cancelled or diminished without at least thirty (30) days prior written notice to Lender. Each insurance policy also shall include an endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lender will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or any other person. Should the Real Property be located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood insurance. Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance, if available, for the full unpaid prancipal balance of the loan and any prior items on the property securing the loan, up to the maximum policy limits set under the National Flood Insurance Program, or as otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the loan. Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage andorsements on otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the loan.

LENDER'S EXPENDITURES. If Grantor fails (A) to keep the Property free of all taxes, liens, security interests, encumbrances, and other claims LENDER'S EXPENDITURES. All such expenses will become a part of the Indebtedness and, at Lender's option, will (A) be payable on demand, (B) be added to the balance of the Credit Agreement and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (1) the term of any appliciable insurance policy, (2) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or (3) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. The Property also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of any default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of any default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust:

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liene and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by. Lender in connection with this Deed of Trust, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Deed of Trust to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning Existing Indebtedness are a part of this Deed of Trust:

EVENTS OF DEFAULT. Grantor will be in default under this Deed of Trust if any of the following happen:

- (1) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the Credit Agreement. This can incl for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition.
  - (2) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the Credit Agreement.
- (3) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral or Lender's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurence, weste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons lieble on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, oreation of a senior lien on the dwelling without our permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default under any indebtedness, or should Grantor fail to comply with any of Grantor's obligations under this Deed of Trust, Trustee or Lender may exercise any one or more of the following rights and

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all rights to have the Property mershalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any pert of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property. The power of sale under this Deed of Trust shall not be exhausted by any one or more sales (or extempts to sell) as to all or any portion of the Real Property remaining unsold, but shall continue unimpaired until all of the Real Property has been sold by exercise of the power of sale and all indebtedness has been paid in full.
