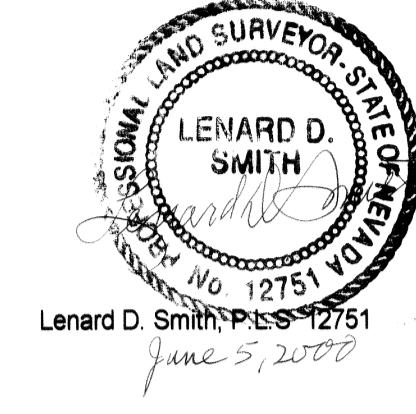


SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

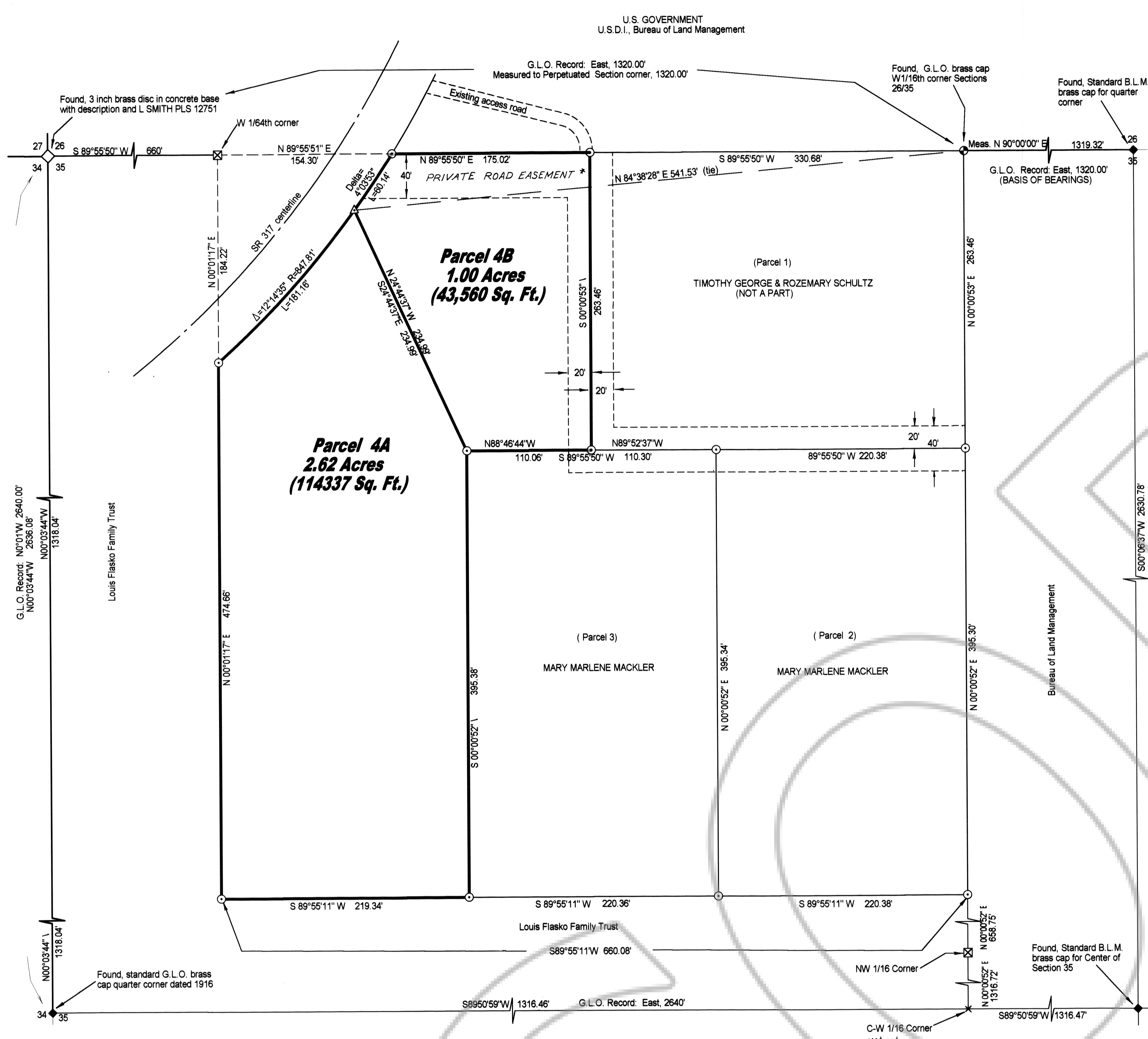

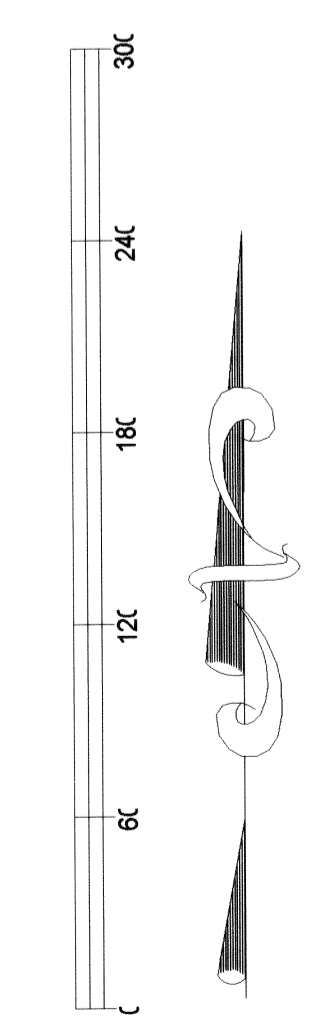
