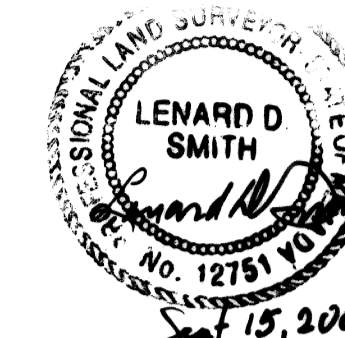


**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE**

I, Lenard D. Smith, a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Nevada, certify that:

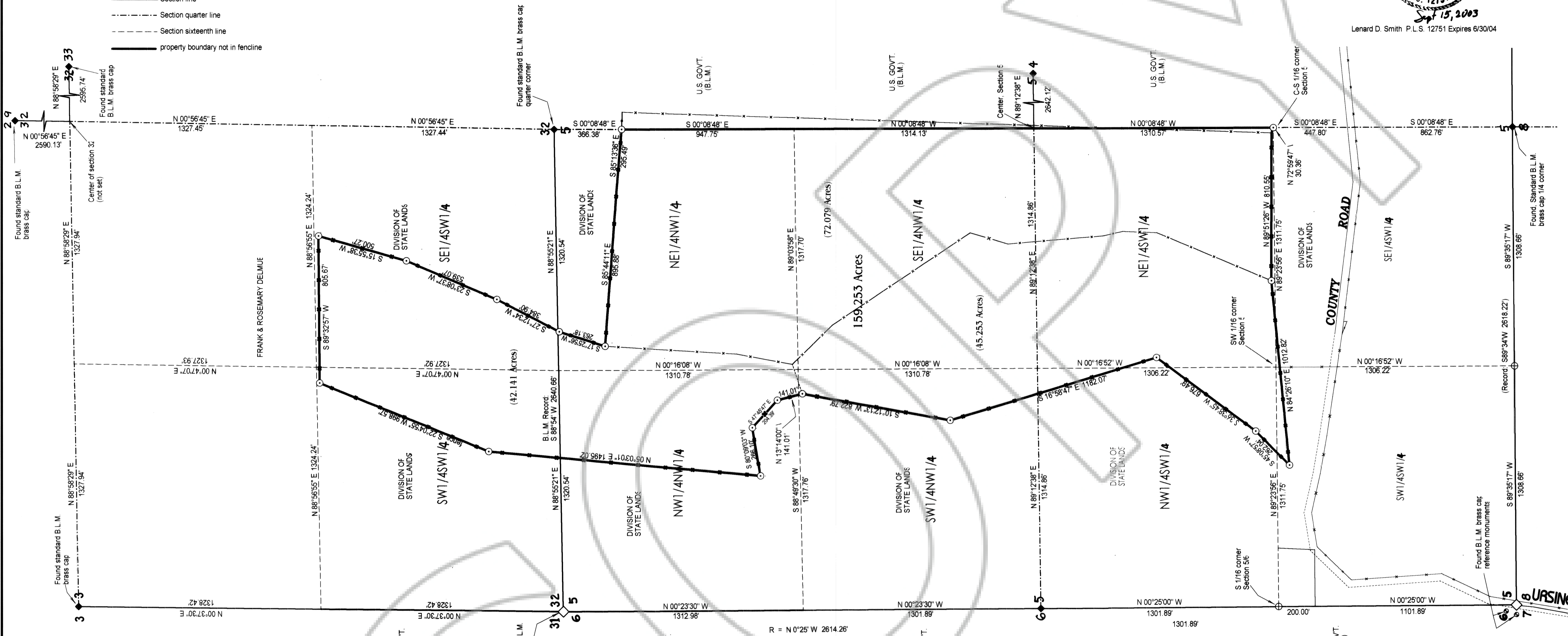
1. This plat represents the results of a survey conducted under my supervision at the instance of Gordon and Betty Lytle.
