- 2* Approve/Deny vouchers (an itemized list of bills is available for public review at the county Auditor's office prior to the meeting).
- 3* Approve/Deny minutes for the November 3, 2003 Commission meeting.

- 5* Accept/Deny/Sign: In accordance with the provisions of NRS 533.280, 533.285 and 533.290, budgets for Ash Springs Irrigation Company and Pabranagat Lakes need to be acted on by the Commission.
- 6* Discussion/Action re: presentation by Tracy Lee of Extreme Technologies, Inc. Mr. Lee will present a report setting forth recommendations concerning the computer system for Lincoln County.
