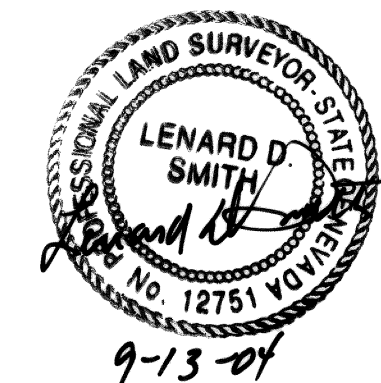

I, Lenard D. Smith, a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Nevada certify that:

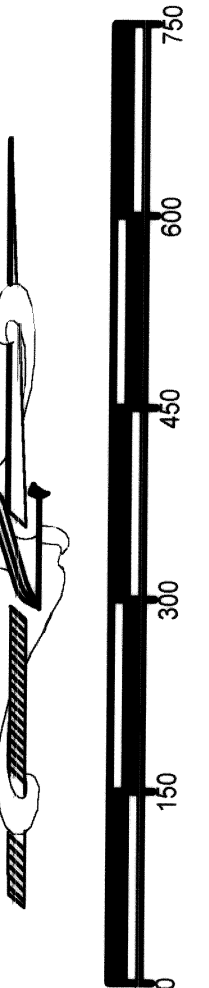
- This plat represents the results of a survey conducted under my supervision at instance of Jerry Mangum.
