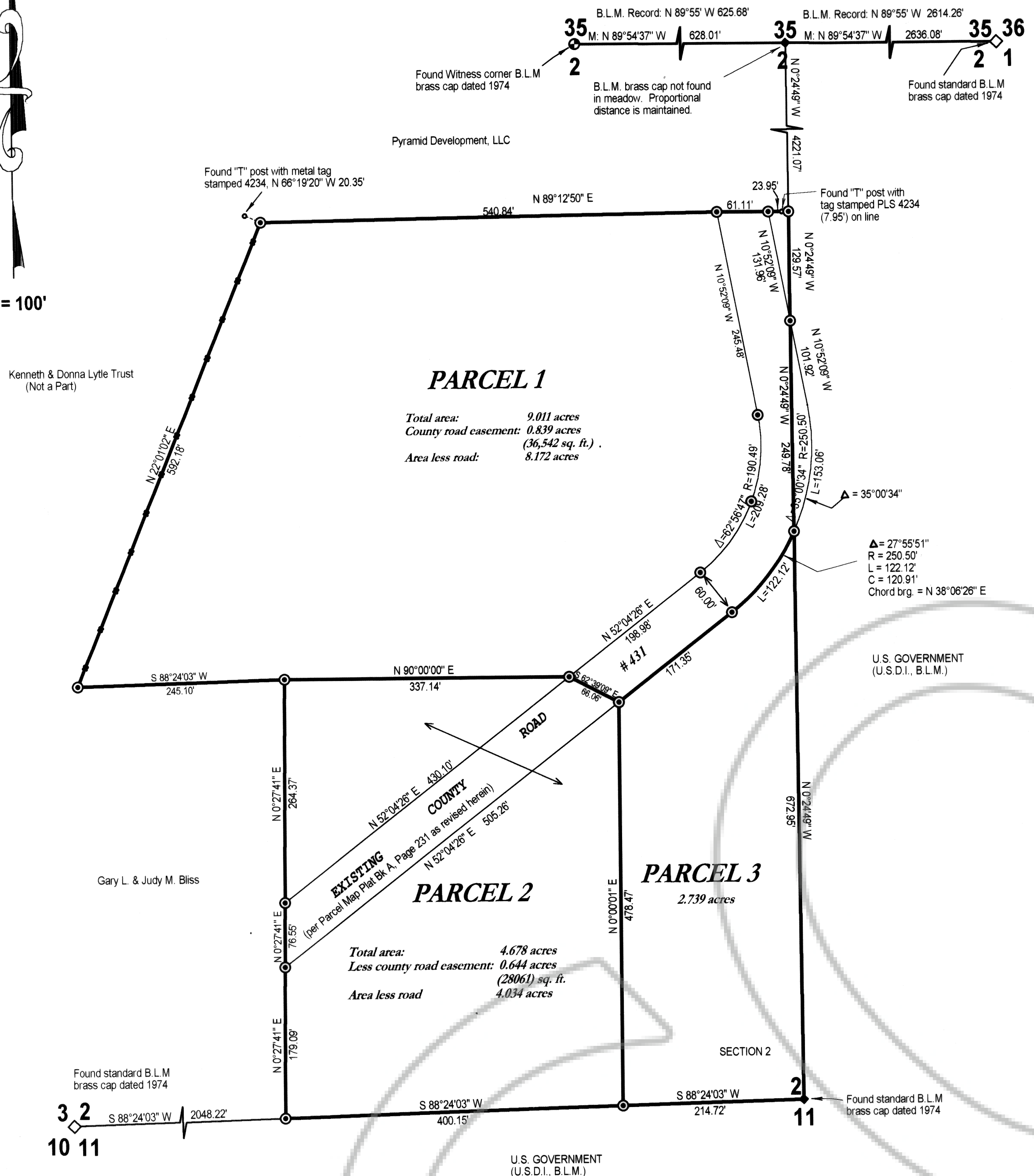

MAP NOTE

The Parcel Map in Plat Book A, at Page 213 of Lincoln County, Nevada Records reorganizes the ownership into 4 parcels. The Reversionary Map of Plat Book A, at Page 331 reverses Parcels 2, 3 and 4 to acreage. Following those establishments, all four parcels change apparent ownership. This map is made to make it possible to clear titles, to correct ownership lines and dedicate the Lincoln County road easement for public purposes. This map subsequently repairs parcels 2 parcels (2 & 3) and amended to correct the apparent inconsistencies in the boundary line between Parcel 1 to Parcels 2 and 3.

BASIS OF BEARINGS

The Basis of Bearings is the south line of the southwest quarter of Section 2, T. 1 N., R. 69 E., M.D.M. as given in the Parcel Map Plat Book A, Page 213, and the Reversion of Acreage Map in Plat Book A, at Page 331 of Lincoln County, Nevada Records. The Bearing used is S 88°24'03" W.

At the regular Meeting of the Lincoln County Planning Commission Meeting held this 14 day of March, 2004, this plat was examined and is hereby recommended for approval.

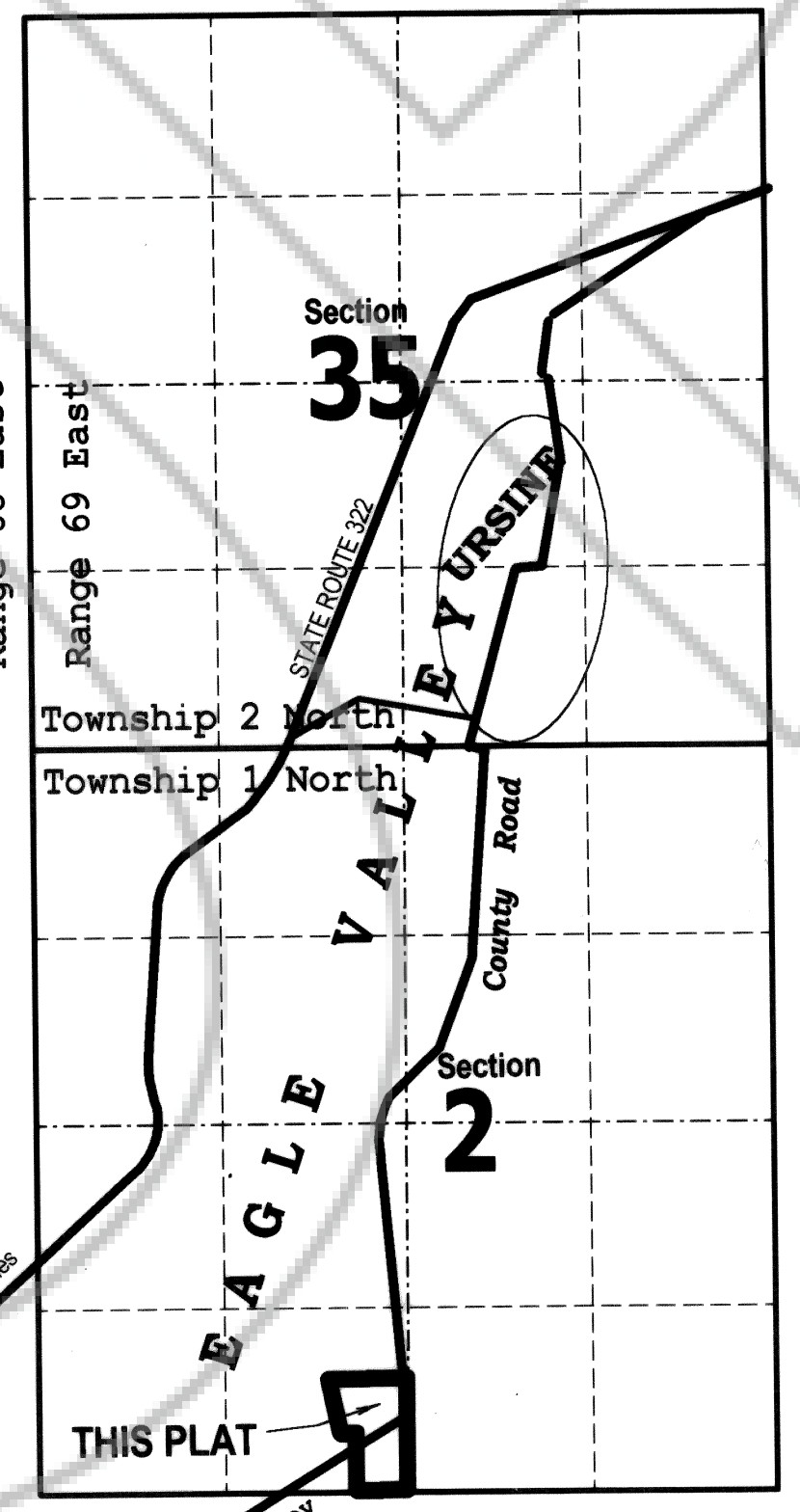

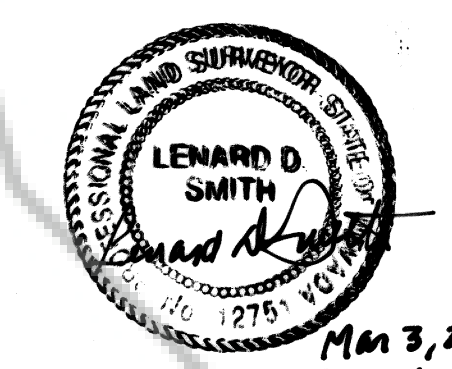


SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

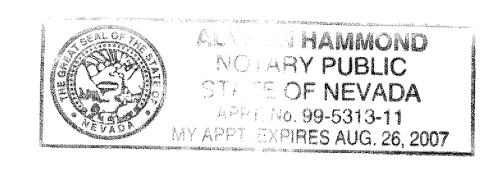
