## ORDER IMPOSING MEDICAID LIEN ON REAL PROPERTY

THIS MATTER came before this Court on April 10, 2009, upon the Petition of the STATE OF NEVADA, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF HEALTH CARE FINANCING AND POLICY ("NEVADA MEDICAID"), by and through CATHERINE CORTEZ MASTO, Attorney General of the State of Nevada, by and through RENE L. HULSE, Deputy Attorney General. The Court having received the evidence finds as follows:

- 1. All notices as required by law have been provided.
- 2. NATHANIEL COLLINS, deceased, was the recipient of Medicaid benefits from January 1, 2007, through February 27, 2008, his date of death.
- 3. The State of Nevada Medicaid Program provided payment for medical services for the care of NATHANIEL COLLINS in the amount of *forty-six thousand one hundred twenty-five dollars and forty-nine cents* (\$46,124.49) through August 28, 2008.

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- 4. The amount of the benefits paid may increase as Medicaid providers have until one year from the date of the death of NATHANIEL COLLINS to bill Medicaid for services rendered.
- 5. The undivided estate of NATHANIEL COLLINS included real property whose common address is 48 Theresa Way, Alamo, County of Lincoln, Nevada 89001 and whose legal description is as follows:

ALAMO SOUTH SUBDIVISION UNIT 2, TRACT 1, LOT 48 APN: 0074-121-16

- At the time of death, the DECEDENT owned the subject property as a Joint 6. Tenant with his spouse, Almeda Collins, and therefore held a one-half (1/2) interest in the property. Pursuant to State and Federal law, the State may only recover on such a lien at a time when there is no surviving spouse, child(ren) under 21, or blind and/or disabled child(ren) of any age, if any. Additionally, the State must release its lien if the surviving spouse, child under 21, or disabled child, if any, seeks to engage in a bona fide sale or financial transaction involving the home.
