ORDER IMPOSING MEDICAID LIEN ON REAL PROPERTY

THIS MATTER came before this Court on February 26, 2010, upon the Petition of the STATE OF NEVADA, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF HEALTH CARE FINANCING AND POLICY ("NEVADA MEDICAID"), by and through CATHERINE CORTEZ MASTO, Attorney General of the State of Nevada, by and through RENE L. HULSE, Deputy Attorney General. The Court having received the evidence finds as follows:

- 1. All notices as required by law have been provided.
- 2. LULA REION LEE, deceased, was the recipient of Medicaid benefits from September 1, 2006, through September 10, 2007, her date of death.
- 3. The State of Nevada Medicaid Program provided payment for medical services for the care of LULA REION LEE in the amount of *forty-nine thousand two hundred sixty dollars and twenty-eight cents* (\$49,260.28) through December 16, 2009. The amount of

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the benefits paid may increase as Medicaid providers have until one year from the date of the death of LULA REION LEE to bill Medicaid for services rendered.

The undivided estate of LULA REION LEE included real property whose 5. common address is 198 Mathews Court, Panaca, Lincoln County, Nevada and whose legal description is as follows:
