19 testimony and argument related thereto, and good cause appearing.

20 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Master's Findings and Recommendations are affirmed
and adopted.**

21 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

22 1. (x) The Obligor is the parent of the following children:

Cody Alan Lamb	April 6, 1995

25 2. (x) A Judgment is entered against Obligor for child support arrears in the amount of
26 \$4,640.77 from January 1, 2006 through October 31, 2009. This shall be paid at
\$150.00 a month starting November 1, 2009 until paid in full.

27 3. (x) The Obligor shall pay \$1,330.00 per month in ongoing support beginning November
28 1, 2009 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order of this Court.



1 All payments MUST be in the form of a cashier's check or money order ONLY. Effective
2 August 1, 2000, all child support payments must be payable to State Collection and
3 Disbursement Unit (SCaDU) and mailed to: SCaDU, P.O. Box 98950, Las Vegas, NV 89193-
4 8950.

5 **NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO
6 THE OBLIGEE OR THE CHILDREN.**

7 Additionally, the Obligor MUST place his/her social security number on each payment.

8 Effective January 1, 2004, simple interest will accrue on all unpaid child support balances for
9 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
10 judgment of the court prior to January 1, 2004 will be enforced.

11 A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an obligation
12 to pay support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095.

13 If you pay your child support through income withholding and your full obligation is not met
14 by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the difference between
15 your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your employer directly to the state
16 disbursement unit. If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
17 interest.

18 **YOU MAY AVOID THESE ADDITIONAL COSTS BY MAKING YOUR CURRENT CHILD
19 SUPPORT PAYMENTS EACH MONTH.**

20 4. (x) The Obligor shall provide health insurance, including medical, dental, orthodontic
21 and ophthalmological coverage for the children as available through his employment,
22 including any group health plan(s) under ERISA, from the date of this order on and
23 until said children are no longer eligible for said coverage, and both parties shall
24 cooperate and provide assistance in obtaining payment for health care services. You
25 are required to notify the Child Support Enforcement Office when health insurance
26 coverage is available or has been terminated.

27 5. (x) The Obligor shall pay health care expenses, including medical, dental, orthodontic,
28 and ophthalmological services for the children as follows: one half of all costs not
covered by insurance, upon being provided by Obligee with adequate
documentation/billing regarding said expenses and any EOB or other insurance
payment documentation.

6. (x) The Obligor shall notify the State Child Support Office or the District Attorney's
Child Support Office of any change of address or employment within ten (10) days.

7. (x) A wage/income withholding shall be issued starting immediately.

8. Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject
to future modifications.

9. Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures
including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of
federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this Order.

10. If any determination of paternity in this Order is at variance with the children's birth
certificate issued in this state, a new birth certificate is to be issued pursuant to NRS 440.325.



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11. The parties shall fill out the attached Court Information Sheet and mail the same to the Nevada State Welfare Division Child Support Enforcement, 3120 East Desert Inn Road, Las Vegas, NV 89121-3857 for filing with the court within ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The parties shall update this form within ten (10) days of it becoming inaccurate.
