BILL OF SALE

FOR GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, and the payment of the sum of one dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Lincoln County Power District No. 1 (the Seller) a general improvement district, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nevada; hereby sells and transfers to the City of Caliente, (the Buyer), a Nevada municipal corporation; the following described real property:

All material and equipment comprising the Caliente Substation located adjacent to Clover Creek Road and near the intersection of U.S. Highway 93 and Clover Creek Road, excluding those items of equipment specifically reserved to the Seller as identified in this Bill of Sale. The location of said substation is more particularly described in the legal description provided in Exhibit A. The Caliente Substation is understood by the parties to include the substation fence, substation ground grid, equipment structures and foundations, bus work, transformers, lightning arresters, switches, fuses and similar power transformation and conveyance equipment located interior to the substation fence. The Caliente Substation being conveyed hereunder excludes the primary metering equipment used by the Seller to measure energy and power deliveries to the Buyer, including associated meters, current transformers, potential transformers, cable, conduit and the like which are retained by the Seller. The Seller does hereby warrant, represent to, and covenant that at the time of execution hereof, the Seller is lawfully possessed in its own right of a good title to the above-described real property and that the Seller has good right and lawful authority to sell and deliver the same, and that the above-described property is free of all encumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature.

The property is sold "as is" and "where is" without any expressed or implied warranty as to condition or acceptability for use. Manufacturer warranties associated with the property, if any, are deemed cancelled by this transfer and the Buyer shall have no recourse against the Seller or the manufacturer of the real property for its failure to function as intended.
