The claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, and 1450 feet is claimed in a East direction and 50 feet in a West direction from the location monument, at which the notice of location is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from West to East.

The location of each corner of this claim is shown on the claim map that is filled herewith. On the ground, each corner of the claim is marked with its appropriate location with a marking pen.

The location post and all corner posts are monument with 2" x 2" wooden posts, 4 feet long, firmly set on the ground. The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 18th day of December, 2011.
