The Obligor shall pay \$230.76 per month in ongoing child support beginning September 1, 2011 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order 5 of this Court. 6 All payments MUST be in the form of a cashier's check or money order ONLY. Effective August 1, 2000, all child support payments must be payable to State Collection and Disbursement Unit (SCaDU) and mailed to: SCaDU, P.O. Box 98950, Las Vegas, NV 8 89193-8950. 9 NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE OR THE CHILD. 10 Additionally, the Obligor MUST place his/her social security number on each payment. 11 12 Effective January 1, 2004, simple interest will accrue on all unpaid child support balances for cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a 13 judgment of the court prior to January 1, 2004 will be enforced. 14 A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an obligation to pay support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095. 15 16 If you pay your child support through income withholding and your full obligation is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the difference 17 between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your employer directly to the state disbursement unit.
