NOTICE OF LIEN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT the State of Nevada, Department of Health & Human Services Division of Health Care Financing and Policy, an agency of the State of Nevada, whose central office is 1000 East Williams Street, Suite 102, Carson City, Nevada 89701, by and through its counsel, Catherine Cortez Masto, Attorney General, and Sabrina Grindle Raetz, Deputy Attorney General, claims a lien pursuant to the AGREEMENT AND LIEN attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, upon the real property commonly known as 390 Sixth Street, Panaca, Nevada 89042 and described as follows:

Lot One Hundred Five (105) in the SUN GOLD MANOR ADDITION to the Town of Panaca, according to the Plat of Record in Book "A" of Plats, page 101, Lincoln County, Nevada records.

The lien is placed for reimbursement of Medicaid benefits paid on behalf of PHYLLIS B. LEE in the amount four hundred thirty-seven thousand four hundred two dollars and fifty-one cents (\$437,402.51) to be paid to Nevada State Division of Health Care Financing and Policy upon sale or transfer of the property.

However, pursuant to State and Federal law, the State may only recover on such a lien at a time when there is no surviving spouse, child(ren) under 21, or blind and/or disabled children of any age, if any. Additionally, the State must release its lien if the surviving spouse, child under 21 or disabled child, if any, seeks to engage in a bona fide sale or financial transaction involving the home. The object of the pending lien action is to secure the State's interest in the property and also allow the survivors to enjoy and benefit from their interest in and use of the property.

AGREEMENT AND LIEN

The State of Nevada, Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Healthcare Financing and Policy ("Nevada Medicaid"), Rollin Kim Lee and David Mark Lee hereby agree as follows:

Phyllis B. Lee received Medicaid benefits from September 1, 2002 to July 11, 2009 totaling four hundred thirty-seven thousand four hundred two dollars and fifty-one cents (\$437,402.51). Phyllis B. Lee passed away on July 11, 2009.

Prior to July 23, 2001, Phyllis B. Lee had an ownership interest in real property commonly known as 390 Sixth Street, Panaca, Nevada 89042 and particularly described as follows:

Lot One Hundred Five (105) in the SUN GOLD MANOR ADDITION to the Town of Panaca, according to the Plat of Record in Book "A" of Plats, page 101, Lincoln County, Nevada records.

Prior to July 23, 2001, Phyllis B. Lee also had an ownership interest in real property commonly known as 367 Sixth Street, Panaca, Nevada 89042 and particularly described as follows:

All of Lot One Hundred Four (104) of SUN GOLD MANOR, Unit No. 1 and the northerly 20 feet of the Lot One Hundred Three (103) of SUN GOLD MANOR Unit No. 1, subdivision to the Town of Panaca, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, being a strip of land 20 feet wide fronting on Sixth Street and extending westerly for the entire depth of said Lot 103, as said Lots are delineated on the official plat of said SUN GOLD MANOR Unit No. 1, now on file and of record in the office of the Lincoln County Recorder, to which plat and the records thereof reference is hereby made for further particular description; together with any and all improvements situate thereon and appurtenance thereunto belonging.

Prior to July 23, 2001, Phyllis B. Lee held the property in joint tenancy with her son, David Mark Lee and therefore, had a 50% interest in the subject property.

On July 23, 2001, Phyllis B. Lee transferred her 50% interest in the subject property to her two

sons, David Mark Lee and Rollin Kim Lee, entitling David Mark Lee to a 75% interest in the property and Rollin Kim Lee to a 25% interest in the property. Phyllis B. Lee transferred all of her interest in the subject property to her sons for \$10.00 consideration.

On November 11, 2002, Rollin Kim Lee applied for Medicaid benefits on behalf of his mother, Phyllis B. Lee. Rollin Kim Lee failed to report on Phyllis B. Lee's Medicaid application that Phyllis B. Lee transferred her 50% interest in the subject property to Rollin Kim Lee and David Mark Lee within Medicaid's 36 month look-back period.

Nevada Revised Statute 422.29302(3) states that Medicaid may pursue any remedy available under Chapter 112 if a Medicaid recipient transfers real property for less than fair market value. Nevada Revised Statute 422.29304(1) also states that Nevada Medicaid shall recover from the person who signed the Medicaid application if that person failed to report any required information, refused to provide information regarding the transfer of assets, or concealed information regarding the transfer of assets on a Medicaid recipient's application.

In lieu of other remedies available to Nevada Medicaid under state law, Nevada Medicaid shall impose a lien in the amount of four hundred thirty-seven thousand four hundred two dollars and fifty-one cents (\$437,402.51) against a 50% interest in the real property described above. Nevada Medicaid's lien is fully enforceable upon sale, transfer and/or refinancing, for purposes other than obtaining more favorable interest terms only, of the subject property.

Nevada Medicaid shall only recover the full amount of its claim, or, the value of 50% interest in the subject property, whichever amount is less. NRS 422.29302(7). Nevada Medicaid cannot recover from a recipient's estate if the recipient has a surviving spouse, disabled or blind child, or minor child. NRS 422.29302(4).
