Mr. Ralph has a degree in Mine Engineering from UNR in Reno. He also has experience in precious metals exploration.

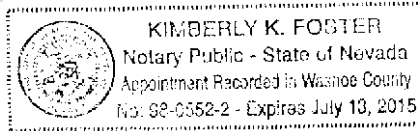
