(x) A Judgment is entered against Obligor for child support arrears in the amount of \$25,806.48 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. This shall be paid at \$430.00 a month starting November 1, 2011 until paid in full. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for interest on child support arrears in the amount of \$9,293.41 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for penalties on child support arrears in the amount of \$2,088.66 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for medical cash arrears in the amount of \$1,054.52 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. This shall be paid at \$40.00 a month starting November 1, 2011 until paidin full. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for interest on medical cash support arrears in the amount of \$324.75 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for penalties on medical cash support arrears

1 in the amount of \$62.25 from December 1, 2006 through October 31, 2011. 2 3. The Obligor shall pay \$110.50 per month in ongoing support beginning November 1, (x)2011 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order of this Court. 3 4. The Obligor shall pay for outstanding paternity testing fees of \$180.00 at the rate of (x)4 \$5.00 per month, commencing November 1, 2011. 5 All payments MUST be in the form of a cashier's check or money order ONLY. Effective August 1, 2000, all child support payments must be payable to State Collection and Disbursement Unit (SCaDU) and mailed to: SCaDU, P.O. Box 98950, Las Vegas, NV 89193-6 8950. 7 NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO 8 THE OBLIGEE OR THE CHILD. 9 Additionally, the Obligor MUST place his/her social security number on each payment. Effective January 1, 2004, simple interest will accrue on all unpaid child support balances for 10 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a 11 judgment of the court prior to January 1, 2004 will be enforced. 12 A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an obligation to pay support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095. 13 If you pay your child support through income withholding and your full obligation is not met 14 by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your employer directly to the state disbursement unit. If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and interest. 16 YOU MAY AVOID THESE ADDITIONAL COSTS BY MAKING YOUR CURRENT CHILD 17 SUPPORT PAYMENTS EACH MONTH. (x)and ophthalmological services for the child as follows: one half of all costs not 23 covered by insurance, upon being provided by Obligee with adequate documentation/billing regarding said expenses and any EOB or other insurance 24 payment documentation 25 (x)The Obligor shall notify the State Child Support Office or the District Attorney's Child Support Office of any change of address or employment within ten (10) days. 26 A wage/income withholding shall be issued starting immediately. 27 Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject 28 to future modifications.
