A Judgment is entered against Obligor for interest on child support arrears in the amount of \$0.00 from 2 December 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014. A Judgment is entered against Obligor for penalties on child support arrears in the amount of \$0.00 from December 1. 3 2013 through April 30, 2014. 4 (x)The Obligor shall pay \$76.00 for paternity testing. This shall be paid at \$5.00 per 5 month starting May 1, 2014 until paid in full. 6 The Obligor shall pay \$257.40 per month in ongoing support beginning May 1. (x)2014 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order of this Court. 7 8 The Obligor shall pay \$0.00 per month in ongoing medical cash support beginning May 1, 2014 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order of this 9 Court. 10 All payments MUST be in the form of a cashier's check or money order ONLY. Effective August 1, 2000, all child support payments must be payable to State Collection and Disbursement Unit (SCaDU) and mailed to: SCaDU, P.O. Box 98950, Las Vegas, NV 89193-12 8950. 13 NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE OR THE CHILD. 14 15 Additionally, the Obligor MUST place his/her social security number on each payment. 16 Effective January 1, 2004, simple interest will accrue on all unpaid child support balances for cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a 17 judgment of the court prior to January 1, 2004 will be enforced. 18 A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an 19 obligation to pay support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095. 20 If you pay your child support through income withholding and your full obligation is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the difference 21 between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your employer directly to the state disbursement unit. (\mathbf{x}) 12 Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject 10. 13 to future modifications. 14 Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures 11. including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of 15 federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this Order. 16 12. If any determination of paternity in this Order is at variance with the child's birth 17 certificate issued in this state, a new birth certificate is to be issued pursuant to NRS 440.325. Therefore, pursuant to NRS 126. 161 Braydn Wayne Willden's birth certificate 18 shall be amended to add Dylan Craig Day as Braydn Wayne Willden's father. 19 13 The parties shall fill out the attached Court Information Sheet and mail or deliver the same 20 to the Nevada State Division of Welfare and Supportive Services; Child Support Enforcement Program; 1470 College Parkway, Carson City, Nevada 89706-7924 for filing 21 with the court within ten (10) days from the date of this order.
