This document is to be notarized and recorded with the Lincoln County Recorder's Office within the timeframe listed in this document.

Special Note: The items listed below reflect a conditions per previously approved SUP #2003-5-2 as well as more recent and current issues with regard to the other proposed uses. Conditions listed below directly reflect the allowance of a solid waste disposal center that includes both a Class I and Class III disposal site, (as defined by NAC 444.5705 and NAC 444.5715 respectively) and a compost plant (as defined by NAC 444.572) on Bedroc Limited LLC, (Bedroc) property located on APN: 008-201-11, 008-201-12 and 008-201-13.

CONDITIONS:

A. Within 30 days of final approval:

 Bedroc shall notarize and record these conditions with the Lincoln County Recorder's Office.

B. Within 180 days, (6 months) of final approval:

 Bedroc and Lincoln County will finalize a Host Fee Agreement regarding placement of solid waste material. This Agreement would satisfy a previously approved condition listed on SUP #2003-5-2.

C. Within 1 year of final approval:

1. Internal staff review of the Special Use Permit. Bedroc may be contacted to discuss current status, issues and related operations.

D. Within 5 years of final approval:

1. Bedroc will have a standard review of conditions of Special Use Permit #2003-5-2, by the Lincoln County Planning Commission.

E. General:

- Bedroc shall comply with applicable permitting requirements as set forth by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection in regard to a Class I and Class III disposal site. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a) Fire Prevention
 - b) Financial Assurances for closure and post closure
 - c) New cell construction
 - d) Groundwater monitoring
 - e) Vector Control
 - f) Compliance with other applicable sections of NRS 444.440 through 444.620 and NAC 444.570 through 4344.7499.
- Bedroc shall comply with applicable permitting requirements as set forth by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection and NAC 444.670 in regard to operation of the Compost Plant.
- 3. Bedroc shall coordinate with NDOT and apply current acceptable practices for maintaining safe access on to US Highway 93.
- 4. Bedroc shall comply with the Lincoln County Code, Title 10, Chapter 4 for all matters relating to Solid Waste Management.
- 5. Bedroc shall obtain all necessary building permits and/or approvals associated with onsite construction, operation and land use.
- 6. Bedroc shall maintain a current Lincoln County Business License.
