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# SCHEDULE A AUTHORITY FOR THE TAKING

The authority for the taking of land is the Act of Congress approved February 26, 1931, as amended (46 Stat. 1421, codified at 40 U.S.C. § 3114); the Act of Congress approved August 1, 1888, as amended (25 Stat. 357, codified at 40 U.S.C. § 3113); 10 U.S.C. § 2663(a); Headquarters Air Force Mission Directive 1-18, 10 July 2014, Paragraph A1.1.3 (delegating authority to condemn real property from the Secretary of the Air Force to the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Installations, Environment and Energy (SAF/IE)); the SAF/IE Re-delegation Memorandum dated 14 August 2015, Paragraph I(B) (re-delegating condemnation authority from the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Installations, Environment and Energy (SAF/IE) to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Installations (SAF/IEI)); Sections 101 and 4101 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2015, Pub. L. No. 113-291, 128 Stat. 3292, 3926, which authorized the appropriation of funds for this acquisition; and the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015, Pub. L. No. 113-235, 128 Stat. 2246, which Act made funds available for this acquisition.

SCHEDULE B PUBLIC PURPOSE

The public purpose for which the land is taken is for the operation of the military test and training facility known as the Nevada Test and Training Range.
