This shall be paid at \$5.00 per month starting the first full month following his release from incarceration until 3 paid in full. 4 (x)The Obligor shall pay \$0.00 in ongoing support beginning January 1, 2017 and 5 then shall pay \$100.00 per month in ongoing support beginning the first full month following his release from incarceration and on the same day each month thereafter 6 until further order of this Court. 7 The Obligor shall pay \$0.00 per month in ongoing medical cash support beginning 8 January 1, 2017 and on the same day each month thereafter until further order of this Court. 9 All payments MUST be in the form of a cashier's check or money order ONLY.
