A 1 ½ inch x 1 ½ inch x 5 foot wooden post at the Northwest corner.

The Placer Claim is approximately 660 feet in the North-South direction and 1,320 feet in the East-West
direction, being the N1/2 NE1/4 SW1/4 (legal subdivision) of the above described section. Said Placer
Claim contains 20 acres, more or less. The Township is unsurveyed and the subject section is non-standard
being designated on the Master Title Plat (last revised June 20, 2009) and on the Nevada Protracted Diagram
No. 176 (dated January 22, 1964, filed on June 14, 1965) as consisting of only 525 acres. Pursuant to BLM
Nevada State Office staff guidance, typical aliquot part designations are assumed in the northern portion of
the subject section (i.e., the N/2), with any potential future lots being designated in the southern portion of the
subject section (i.e., the S/2). Notwithstanding, the legal description herein is subject to revision in the event
that the United States surveys the Township and designates lots anywhere within the subject section.
