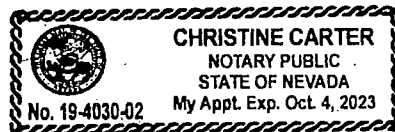

17 This matter was heard on June 11, 2021 for the Notice and Finding of Financial
18 Responsibility. The Court Master with the following were present:

23 After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and
24 Recommendations:

25 The Obligor was properly served on March 19, 2021, with a Notice and Finding of Financial
26 and Responsibility.

27 Obligor is the parent of [] born [].

1 Using Obligor's testimony and Financial Statement, Obligor's gross monthly earnings
2 are \$4,600.00. Pursuant to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425
3 et seq., 16% of those earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$736.00 per month.

4 The monthly child support obligation recommended in paragraph 1 below is considered
5 based on the following provisions contained in NAC 425.150:

15 The child support amount recommended by the Court Master (set out in paragraph 1
16 below) deviates from the statutory percentage under NAC 425 et seq., based on the
17 Obligor's cost of insurance for the child in the amount of N/A. NAC 425.135

18 The monthly child support amount recommended in paragraph 1 below deviates/is
19 adjusted from the statutory percentage under NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq.,
20 based on the reasonable cost of childcare in amount of N/A and the Obligor will share
21 the equitable amount of N/A as part of the monthly child support obligation. NAC
22 425.130.

23 THE RECOMMENDED ORDER:

- 24 1. The Obligor shall pay \$736.00 per month in ongoing support beginning
25 July 1, 2021. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18 years
26 of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High School.
27 However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to live on
28 their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable,
continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.
2. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$4,416.00 for September 1, 2020
through June 30, 2021.

1 To be paid by payments of **\$35.00** per month beginning July 1, 2021.

2 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check
3 and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent
4 to:

8 The following information must be included with each payment:

- 9 A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.
10 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.
11 C. Child support case number 444-94-3100A listed on each payment.
12 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

13 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**
14 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**
15 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**
16 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

17 3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation
18 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the
19 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
20 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
21 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
22 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
23 payments each month.

24 4. The Obligee will cover the child's medical, vision, or dental health insurance needs
25 using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The accessible
26 and reasonable cost of medical support for the child is the amount of **\$0.00** per month.
27 The Obligor will pay **\$0.00** for the monthly medical cash support. NAC 425.135.

28 5. Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care
which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical,
dental, orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a

1 parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by
2 insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days
3 of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent
4 1/2 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for
5 reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision
6 must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the
7 other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

8 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
9 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
10 access to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy
11 information) within 10 days of such change.

12 7. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.
13 Payment is to be made directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND
14 DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). At any time withholding does not occur, Obligor
15 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT
16 UNIT (SCaDU).

17 8. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
18 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for
19 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
20 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
21 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).

22 9. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and
23 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders
24 Act.

25 10. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the child.

Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.
